ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BOLTON AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF GAMES OF CHANCE BY AUTHORIZED ORGANIZATIONS WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL LIMITS OF THE TOWN

SECTION 1

It shall be lawful for any authorized organization, as defined in Section 186 (4) of Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law, upon obtaining the required license, to conduct games of chance, as defined in Section 186 (3) of Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law, within the territorial limits of the town of Bolton, subject to the provisions of this ordinance, and Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law, and particularly subject to the restrictions contained in Sec. 189 of said law.

SECTION 2

In addition to the frequency of games authorized by Sec. 195-b of the General Municipal Law, it shall be lawful for any authorized organization to conduct games of chance in the Town of Bolton on the first day of the week, commonly known and designated as Sunday only between the hours of noon and midnight, except no games of chance shall be conducted on Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or New Year's Eve.

SECTION 3

Except as provided in Section 195-k of the General Municipal Law, the provisions of this ordinance and of Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law shall remain inoperative unless and until a proposition therefor submitted at a special election in the Town of Bolton shall be approved by a vote of the majority of the qualified electors of the Town voting thereon.
