Once again GRSP will be offering the always-popular Sunday program in its traditional format, and also the Thursday/Friday afternoon/evening options for a variety of ski and snowboard activities at the North Creek Ski Bowl.

***Thursday/Friday Program at the Ski Bowl***

**Transportation is parent responsibility.**

Join us each week on Thursday and/or Friday evenings for skiing and snowboarding. Gore staff will provide on-hill coaching for 3 hours, 4-7pm, with a variety of fun ski/ride activities.

***At The Bowl, we'll also offer lessons to beginner parents who are skiing or snowboarding for the first time for \$15/day. (lift ticket and rental sold separately, on a daily basis)***

**Lesson Time** (as assigned by Gore Mountain)

Schools will keep the assigned lesson time from last season, and must attend the same session time each week. Chaperones and/or Parents are **required** to meet children when the lessons are over. Skiers are to meet and be picked up in front of the Northwoods Lodge. Snowboarders are to meet and be picked up at the J-Bar.

**Lessons for Parents:**

Parents are welcome to take lessons at the same time as their children's respective school lessons. Gore will group parents with other parents of like ability. Parent lessons sold individually on a daily basis, each week that you come.

### Application

### Registration

Registration packets are due to Michelle Huck on or before 9:00 AM on Friday December 7, 2018.

**No late registrations will be accepted.**

### Helmets

Helmets are required for all participants ages 17 and under. Helmets are available for rent on a weekly basis at the Gore rental shop. Anyone renting ski or snowboard equipment will have a helmet included in their rental package.

### Program Pass Photos

Gore can use pass photos from last year for this year's program, as long it is less than 3 yrs old. Students who are either new to the program or would prefer to have their photo updated can visit Gore any day from now until December 14, 2018 9am-3pm to have their photo taken.

Students can also email a photo (head shot) to [sp@goremountain.com](mailto:sp@goremountain.com) . Be sure to write the program/school name along with the photo.

### Transportation

Advance sign up will be required the Wednesday before we ski by 3:00 PM. A minimum of 5 students will be needed in order for a bus to be provided. If 5 students sign up, a bus will be available at Bolton Central School each Sunday the program occurs. Students should be dropped off at 8:00 AM, we depart at 8:15 AM and picked up at BCS at 4:00 PM. (Bus leaves/returns from school promptly. Tardiness will result in bus privileges being revoked).

**Participants age 10 and under must have a parent/guardian with them at Gore. All residents are welcome to ride the bus.**

**Parent Lift Tickets** Parent "Chaperone" tickets are available to parents only with children in the program, you are responsible for only your child(ren).

**Sunday Program:** Please send your request for a ticket to [boltonrec@yahoo.com](mailto:boltonrec@yahoo.com) by 3:00 PM the Wednesday prior to each week's program. Chaperones will purchase and pick up their own ticket for \$50 at the Season Pass Sales Desk, bring photo ID each Sunday of the program.

**Thursday/Friday evening Program:** Please send your request for a ticket to [boltonrec@yahoo.com](mailto:boltonrec@yahoo.com) by 3:00 PM Monday prior to each week's program. Chaperones will purchase and pick up their own ticket for \$22/day each Thursday and/or Friday at the Ski Bowl Lodge ticket desk, bring photo ID. **If you agree to ride the lift with your child or students from our school you will receive a FREE lift ticket!** Chaperone tickets are available to parents only with children in the program.

**Meeting place in lodge**

The Sunday Bolton School group congregates in the Gore Mountain Base Lodge on the lower level cafeteria section all the way in the back. If you do not pick up your ski pass from the Recreation Center before the first day of programming or you have a question you can look for Michelle in this location or at the ski lesson gathering location at 10:15 AM. You will be notified when your pass is available for pick up.

**Frequent Skier/Rider Discounts**

Those participants attending all 6 weeks of lessons will receive Frequent Skier Discount lift tickets for the remainder of the 18-19 season. Just present their GRS pass to any Gore Mountain ticket window to receive their non-transferrable lift ticket. Your GRS Pass must be presented for discount.

**Eligibility for Evening program and Sunday program:**

All participants must be 5 to 18 years of age and enrolled in the participating town's school District. Any child not registered with the town's school district will not be eligible for participation. Those who are home schooled and reside in participating towns are eligible. Those living in non-participating towns but attend a participating town's school are also allowed in this program.
