Dear Parents and Student,

Please read and sign the following form. **A minimum of 5 students are needed in order for The Town of Bolton to offer a bus ride to Gore each Sunday. There is no bus offered for the Thursday Friday program.**

The Bolton Central School bus is available for students that are enrolled at the Bolton Central School, or who are residents of the Town. Friends or family from out of Town may not ride the school bus. Adult and student Residents of the Town who are not enrolled in the Gore Mountain program are only able to ride the bus if there is seating available.

Any students who is picked up/dropped off late to or from BCS, causes the bus to depart later than scheduled from Gore, or does not conduct themselves appropriately on the bus, (i.e. inappropriate language, bullying, not listening to chaperones etc.), will not be permitted to use the bus for the remainder of the program or at the discretion of the Recreation Director and the Chaperones.

There will be program chaperones at Gore Mountain throughout the day. However, it is important to understand that the chaperones are not able to maintain visual contact of all students during the day. Please be aware that in the event of an emergency Gore Staff will contact the chaperones. Student's ages 10 and younger are required to have a parent/guardian with them. Any parent wishing to ski with their child may obtain a "parent chaperone pass" at a discounted rate by contacting the Program Advisor, Michelle, the Wednesday before to let her know they will be skiing.

I have reviewed the following information with my child, and we understand and agree to the above rules. Furthermore, any behavioral issues that may occur which have not been mentioned above will be addressed individually by the Recreation Director.
