At some point in the future, we shall meet to discuss the Recreation Center, and the Gore Regional School Program, in order to provide a basic understanding of the larger programs overseen in the Department.
  - C. Received the Transportation bill from BCS for June-December 2009 totaling \$3,462.65. Will attempt to make contact with the billing office again, to see if it will be possible to receive this statement in 2009.
