1. Budget- *Discussed LGTL and how the group will no longer fall under the Recreation Department realm, but act as an independent organization in the future when seeking funds.*
2. Recreation Center
 - A. Victoria O'Donnell resigned from her position as Recreation Center attendant in December. Denise Johnson has been hired to temporarily fill the position as the position will be advertised in the spring.
 - B. Calendar-See reverse
 - C. Attendance-December=43 students.
3. Winter Programs
 - A. Gore Regional School Program-29 participants this year, with an average of 6 people riding the van. Deb Gaddy will be chaperoning the remaining trips this season.
4. Summer Programs-
 - A. Veteran's Park Pavilion-A second ramp would be useful in assisting those in wheelchairs access the new docks and the beach area. *Two new ramps would be most beneficial to handicapped individuals and parents.*
 - B. Fourth of July Band? *It was decided that there are enough events occurring that day.*
5. Other
 - A. Community Boat Cruise-Available dates are June 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9. I would suggest Wednesday June 3 or Tuesday June 9, however it will depend on what date I can book the entertainment and what is still available at the Steamboat Company.
 - B. Warren County Safe and Quality Bicycling Organization-WCSQBO represent all municipalities in Warren County, and have been recognized by the County Board of Supervisors as a Citizens Advisory Committee. One detail they try to introduce cyclists to are the beautiful and enjoyable rides in our county and to organize rides in each on the municipalities which are free and allow people to experience the fine side roads, views, and historically interesting areas. Lloyd Mott and I have reviewed road maps and taken a drive selecting two routes in Bolton Landing for the WCSQBO to take over the summer.
 - C. *Per Deb's request I have already reached out to Mr. Graney at BCS to discuss the possibility of an ice-skating rink being set up on school property for community use. I will also be contacting Pete O or Matt from Up Yonda Farm to discuss that location as a possible site for an ice skating rink.*
