1. There were 75 attendees at the Boat Cruise this year, down from 162 in 2013. The weather and a local funeral severely impacted this event. The LG Steamboat Company generously reduced our rate by \$500 due to the weather conditions, bringing the total to \$1,025.00 for the charter.
2. The Summer Schedule has been mailed to all Bolton and Diamond Point residents, a total of 1,195 to Bolton and 502 to Diamond Point arrived in mailboxes on 6/13/14.
