1. Recreation Center-
  - A. Attendance- September 46, October 54, November 48 participants.
  - B. December Calendar-see attached
  - C. Kelli Street has been hired to work as the new recreation center attendant. Her start date was Tuesday November 29.
2. Winter Programs-
  - A. The deadline for applications for the Gore Regional School Program was Friday December 2. Nineteen students are enrolled in the program this season.
  - B. Currently, all recreation dept. exercise programs have ended for 2016. Yoga and LaBlast will begin again in January. Watercolor painting classes continue to run as scheduled on Tuesday from 10:00-1:00 at the Community Center.
  - C. Summer Programs-NA
  - D. The free Louis van Amstel Dance event was well attended by people on November 12, 2016. The morning event saw 40 participants and the evening event had 50 participants.
  - E. After conducting a routine playground inspection, I discovered dry rot on the monkey bar support beam. The distributor no longer makes wooden replacement parts, and therefore recommended a professional installer be hired to install the new system as it requires adjustments be made to the existing structure. I have ordered the required parts needed to make the repairs to the playground. The parts should arrive to the contractor approximately 12/22/16. He has stated he will schedule the installation as soon as he can from the time he receives the parts.
