- 2. 2. Recreation Center-
 - A. Calendar- See reverse
 - B. Attendance-See Attached
 - C. School Vacations/Holidays- It is the practice of the Recreation Center to follow the school calendar; therefore it is typically closed on days when the school is closed. However, if there is the opportunity to be opened or a request by parents for more available days, we will accommodate. There is very little use of the facility during school vacations, but it was opened four days during the December Vacation including New Year's Day.
 - D. The Recreation Center received a \$1,100 matching fund for 2011 from the Warren County Youth Bureau. Copies of the application are available by contacting Michelle Huck.
- 3. Winter Programs-
 - A. Gore-Three trips remaining for 2011.
- 4. Summer Programs-
 - A. As of now I plan to work this summer, as I have been told that it would be possible to have a more flexible work arrangement to eliminate my original desire to have a sixteen week leave of absence.
 - B. Summer planning is underway, with a goal of 85-90% of all tasks to be completed in April.
 - C. Bolton Summer Day Camp 2011

 - 2. Final vote on 2011 Pricing-\$300 to cover a six-week camp and all of the field trips.
 - D. Roger's Park- It has been brought to my attention that restrooms are likely to be built in Roger's Park on the beach where the existing pump station is. Mr. Conover had requested that the Recreation Commission play an active role in the planning of this project. We have discussed how it would be beneficial to have adequate storage space in this facility to act as the new storage area/office for the lifeguards and beach equipment. The room would need to be equipped with a locking door, phone capabilities, electrical outlets, ventilation/windows, and ideally a small desk and storage shelves.
