Deputy Supervisor Andersen explained that due to a change in policy from Ford Motor Company concerning the close out date for newly built trucks, we have received notification that two bidders can no longer honor their quotes.

RESOLUTION #65

Councilman Andersen moved seconded by Councilman Saris to rescind RESOLUTION #59 which was to accept the low bid from Orange Motors in the amount of \$18,999 for one new 2005 Ford F250 ¾ ton pickup, v-8 gasoline engine, color grey with no plow. All Favorable. Motion Carried.

The second low bidder is willing to supply a 2006 model for their same quoted bid.

RESOLUTION#66

Councilman Andersen moved seconded by Councilman Saris to award the bid for a new 2006 Ford F250 ¾ ton pickup, V-8 gasoline engine with no plow to the second low bidder, Van Bortel Ford Inc. in the amount of \$19,245.00. All Favorable. Motion Carried.

Warren Ford after accepting our award called back and stated he could not honor the bid for the quoted price. His new price for the truck was \$32,208.

RESOLUTION#67

Councilman Andersen moved seconded by Councilman Saris to rescind RESOLUTION #60 which was to accept the accept the low bid from Warren Ford for one new 2005 F350 one ton dump with plow, 8' dump box V8 automatic gas engine, color dark green. All Favorable. Motion Carried.

The second low bidder is willing to supply a 2006 model for the same quoted bid.

RESOLUTION#68

Councilman Andersen moved seconded by Councilman Saris to award the bid for one new 2006 one ton dump with plow, 8' dump box V8 automatic gas engine, color dark green to the second low bidder, Van Bortel Ford, Inc. in the amount of \$30,545.00. All Favorable. Motion Carried.
