NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to Resolution of the Board of Fire Commissioners, a special election of the qualified voters of the Bolton Fire District in the Town of Bolton, New York, will be held at the Bolton Fire Station, 5003 Lake Shore Drive, Bolton, New York, on September 20, 2022, between the hours of 6:00 o'clock P.M. and 9:00 o'clock P.M. to vote upon the following propositions:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall the portion of the Bond Resolution entitled:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF REAL PROPERTY AND THE ISSUANCE OF UP TO \$720,000 IN SERIAL BONDS OF THE BOLTON FIRE DISTRICT TO PAY THE COSTS OF REAL PROPERTY; AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF UP TO \$720,000 IN BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES OF THE FIRE DISTRICT FOR THE SAME PURPOSE

relating to authorization of purchase of such real property which was duly adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Bolton Fire District on June 2, 2022, be approved?

PROPOSITION NO. 2

Shall the portion of the Bond Resolution entitled:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF REAL PROPERTY AND THE ISSUANCE OF UP TO \$720,000 IN SERIAL BONDS OF THE BOLTON FIRE DISTRICT TO PAY THE COSTS OF REAL PROPERTY; AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF UP TO \$720,000 IN BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES OF THE FIRE DISTRICT FOR THE SAME PURPOSE

relating to issuance of bonds and/or bond anticipation notes to finance the cost of purchasing real property intended to be used for a new Fire Station which was duly adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Bolton Fire District on June 2, 2022, be approved?

Every elector of the Town of Bolton, Warren County, New York, who is a registered voter of the Town and who has resided in the Bolton Fire District for the 30 days immediately before the date of the special election shall be qualified to vote on the proposition.
