Town Policy on Highway Department Sweeping Private Parking Lots

Supervisor Gabriels: We have to establish a sweeping policy for the Highway Dept. for the sweeping of private parking lots within the hamlet area as part of the Highway Dept.'s normal routine. This is really a codification and he hopes it is perceived as a codification of historic practices. The Town Board is adopting this policy because it would like to go on record encouraging the Town Highway Dept. to continue sweeping parking lots in order to maintain the beautification and cleanliness of the Bolton hamlet area.

RESOLUTION #147

Councilman Maranville moved, seconded by Councilman MacEwan to adopt Town Policy that the Highway Department continue the sweeping of the private parking lots in the hamlet as listed in the Highway Dept.'s proposal and to also include the following parking lots: Lake George Land Conservancy (former Tavern on the Pond) and Hometown Diner. All favorable. Motion passed.

MEMORANDUM OF POLICY AND UNDERSTANDING
DEPARTMENT
SWEEPING

PRIVATE PARKING LOTS

WHEREAS the Town Bolton takes great civic pride in maintaining a and orderly hamlet including the mechanical sweeping of thoroughfares, public recreation areas and municipal parking areas, and

WHEREAS the Town of Bolton in keeping and maintaining public areas and orderly finds it appropriate to include certain and specific areas of private property that is open for public access in and area hamlet area so as to comprehensively mechanically sweep all areas to keep them reasonably clean, and

WHEREAS the Town of Bolton Highway Department has in a cooperative effort remained willing to certain larger and predominate private parking lot areas to be part the general program, and

WHEREAS specified private parking lot owners from time to time grant permission and the Town of Bolton Highway Department to have access to their private parking area for the purpose of

NOW AND THEREFORE he it hereby RESOLVED that the following shall constitute a policy and understanding of the Town of Bolton and the Town of Bolton Highway Superintendent with respect to the use and application of town employees and town equipment for the

- 1) As part of a general method and application of municipal public way and public parking area mechanical sweeping provided by the Town of Bolton Highway Department the Town Highway Superintendent, Highway Department employees and town equipment shall be permitted to sweep and clean parking lots the same shall constitute as overall clean, orderly and and debris free" system of management the Town of Bolton hamlet area, which is and understood to the primary areas New York State Route
- 2) The Town of Bolton Highway Superintended act in such manner and within the understandings of this policy only upon the consent of the custodian or occupant of the private lot owner, custodian or
- 3) The services herein specified are rendered at no cost, without expectation of gratuity and solely for the purpose of keeping the hamlet and commercial areas within the Town of Bolton clean and as part a general program intended to promote the general welfare, health and well-being of the citizens and visitors in the Town of Bolton.

4) The method, frequency, duration and application of the mechanical sweeping program made available under the terms and understandings herein specified shall remain within the sound discretion and authority of the Town Highway Superintendent and with the approval of the Town Board by the terms of this resolution,

5) Those specific enumerated private parking lot areas associated with hamlet commercial locations and which serve commercial establishments while also affording substantial parking access in the hamlet area of the Town of Bolton and which constitute locations that may benefit from this policy are; Neuffer's, Frank's, Grand Union and Stewart's. Other similar locations may be designated between the Highway Superintendent and the owner/custodian/occupant of a private parking area open to the public as discretion may require in order to implement the purposes of the policy and understanding herein stated.

The foregoing constitutes the policy of the Town Board and the Town Highway Superintendent to be approved by the foregoing resolution.
