1. Recreation Center
 - A. Attendance- January 76, February 48
 - B. Calendar-See Reverse
2. Winter Programs-
 - A. Gore-The six week program was a success and Gore is offering discount rates to participants, 25% off weekend passes and 50% off weekday passes when students present their GRSP pass.
 - B. Free Fitness Day- We had 14 participate on 2/21/15 in the free Zumba and Aerobics workouts.
3. Summer Programs
 - A. The Lead Camp Counselor and WSI will be returning for the 2015 season. An add will be placed for lifeguards and counselors in the spring
 - B. Summer Day Camp- Registration night will be March 24. I will increase the age limit to 13 years old and attempt to incorporate 2 activities /week just for 11-13 year olds in an attempt to make the program more appealing to the older children. This will include "public" volleyball or some athletic one day each week, an offsite field trip, and the option to participate in Guard Start. I am also going to offer a weekly rate for vacationers or those who cannot participate in the entire six weeks. The program for 6 weeks is \$350; I propose a fee of \$150 for people wishing to purchase individual weeks.
 - C. The Community Boat Cruise will be Tuesday June 9, 2015. I have hired Tom Brady to provide the musical entertainment from 5-7pm.
 - D. The Mettawee River Theater Company will not be returning to Bolton this season, in fact, this is their "finale season" after 40 years and will be only performing shows closer to home this summer.

Other-

1. Summer Day Camp Parent visiting Regina Cornell-Family, *we discussed programs which may be appealing to the older kids including activities and trips. While separate trips for the older children would be ideal, I explained that money and staffing are two major concerns. I have ideas for separate off site trips; however, without finding another 21 year old individual with the two required NYSDOH certifications, I will still have to have all children remain together, but offer alternate programming for 11-13 year olds a few times each week. Minimum age for a counselor is 16.*
