Supervisor Gabriels called the meeting to order at 7:00 a.m. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss an amendment to our Water Regulations that would prohibit water district customers from drilling wells. The board will discuss further at our regular board meeting.

Letter from Mrs. McCleery concerning a water leak they experienced over the winter. She is asking for some relief since the leak did not enter the sewer system. The board would like some more information regarding the leak before making a decision. We will ask Counsel to address these requests.

Letter from Al Dague requesting to be considered for a job if an opening occurs.

Councilman Saris moved seconded by Councilman Andersen to accept the bid from Perry Landscaping in the amount of \$6025, pending approval of Counsel that we met the bidding requirements. Two other people were contacted and both were too busy to place bids. Letters are on file stating such. Funds will be taken from the Rogers Park fund and the bed tax monies. All Favorable Motion Carried.

Councilman Saris and Engineer Carl Schoder discussed our I&I (infiltration & inflow) problem at the sewer plant. One day alone the plant took in 800,000 gallons. There are products available for sealing manholes, which might alleviate some of our problems. Mr. Schoder offered to do some inspections and make suggestions that might help.

Councilman Andersen moved seconded by Councilman Saris to adjourn at 8:00 a.m. All Favorable. Motion Carried.
